The Western Canada Leadership Accelerator held in Regina on September 25-27, 2019, initiated an important conversation about the mobilization of Canadian leaders.

The 2019 Western Canada Leadership Accelerator delivered on its promise: Immersive Growth, Energy & Impact to Supercharge the Path, Purpose & Performance of Canadian Leaders.

Over the course of three days, close to 200 leaders engaged in a non-typical and thought-provoking Accelerator. Key conversations included:



How exactly to we get from point A, where we are now to point B, where we ultimately want to go? There is a more strategic - almost athletic - way to advance progressively as leaders.



What do we need to start doing to mobilize leaders grounded in purpose, potential and personal fulfillment more effectively? What do we need to stop doing?



How are we utilizing technology to up-level how we lead, scale our sphere of influence and impact and grow deeper connections?



What isn't being said? We have all been to far-too-many typical leadership conferences and events. What non-typical aspects of leadership need our focus?



What does it mean to be a values-based leader, and how do they show up in business, community and their personal life? How do they approach teams, management and community leadership? All of these areas are connected and affected by our values.



Who were you born to be? Developing your core story uncovers your innate 'Who' and your compelling 'What'.
